WE NEED TO HEAR YOUR VOICE

In a nutshell, from the School's Directors:

Guildford Diocese, the owners of the building, want to formalise the relationship we have in renting the building through a long-term lease agreement. Until now we haven't had this security.

GREAT: This means we have stability and can apply for grants etc.

HOWEVER: There's also a long-term financial commitment required to cover the annual rent and funds for building maintenance and improvement.

We need to know:

1. Do you, the people of Pixham, want Old Pixham School to continue as a community centre?
2. If so, will you step forward to help fund-raise to cover lease costs + cost of maintaining & running the building?
3. Can you give some time to support in the running of the School?

Is a crucial meeting for the future of Old Pixham School. Without the support of the community, Old Pixham School cannot commit to a lease. Chaired by the Pixham Residents' Association, the School's Directors will outline the possibilities and challenges of having a lease and answer your questions. Message from Richard Cattell – OPS Director

In July 1880, Pixham School opened for business, with the first class of 27 pupils attending the newly opened school. Sadly, July 2012, 132 years later saw the school gates close for the very last time. Many of Pixham's long-standing residents went to school in Pixham and many of our kids went to school there too.

However, the end of teaching wasn't the end of Pixham School. A few Pixham residents, supported by an army of local helpers got together and started to transform the school and we set up Old Pixham School CIC, (Community Interest Company). We are a not-for-profit organisation, the purpose of which is to act as a community hub for the benefit of Pixham residents. All the directors, supporters and the building manager give their time for free.

Old Pixham School (OPS) has hosted pop-up pubs, coffee mornings, cinema nights, quiz nights, parties, seasonal events, and even the odd wedding reception! We also take private rental bookings to supplement our income, to allow us to keep the building running for the community at large. Every penny we get through fund-raising and through private bookings is spent on maintaining the building (she's quite old now) and on improving the facilities that we can offer to the community and to allow us to compete for private rentals
